NEW MUSIC PROTOCOLS

ENTERING THE CLASSROOM

If coming in from outside, use hand sanitizer first

If you haven't washed your hands, please line up to do so before touching reeds and mouthpiece

Sit in your cohort.

No sharing instruments, reeds, mouthpieces, stands, or music.


Cohorts will take turns setting up instruments

Only one student assigned to a school instrument this year, no doubling up.

If your case is small enough to tuck under your chair, you can set up there. If it's too big you must set up at the side of the room.

If you forget your instrument or music, you'll have worksheets to do instead. Bring a pencil.

WHERE DO I GO?




TEACHER ZONE

BIG INSTRUMENTS GO HERE!

STORE INSTRUMENTS HERE!

SET UP OVER YOUR CASE

Set up and take your instrument apart over your case

People who take their instrument apart during class (taking valves out etc) will be asked to put their instrument away for the rest of class.



SANITZE!

Hand Sani or wash your hands before you get your instrument and DEFINITELY before you touch any mouthpieces or reeds

Wash your hands when you get back to class after band. Wash your hands in the band room if this is your last class of the day.





PAPER TOWEL & GARBAGE

Paper towel goes in the blue bin by the sink

Regular paper goes in the cardboard box by the door

There is no garbage can. Garbage and reeds needs to go home and be thrown out there

No food garbage because no eating in the music room!





NO GARBAGE!

Again, there is NO GARBAGE in the music room.

Anything you bring in must go out.

There should be ZERO FOOD GARBAGE in here because you are not allowed to eat in the music room.



STAY IN YOUR LANE

We'll be sitting in cohorts, not instrument groups, inside the taped lanes.

Keep your things within your lane!















NO TOUCHING!

Hands off of percussion equipment, the piano, and anything in the music room that is not specifically yours to use









MY INSTRUMENT IS BROKEN!

Unfortunately, it's not really covid-safe for me to fix your instrument in class. Make do however you can for the rest of class and I will fix it as soon as possible!

No valves out of trumpets in the music room.

Too spitty!



SPIT HAPPENS

If you need to empty your spit valve, you need to walk to the sink and turn the water on.

Empty your spit valve into the running water.

Wash your hands in the running water.

Return to your seat and continue with class.

If you empty your spit onto the floor, you will be asked to put away your instrument for the rest of class.
